The Abbey Church of the Holy Cross, Pershore

The Abbey has been a centre for Christian Worship for over 1300 years and is one of the finest examples of Norman and Early English architecture in the country. It can easily accommodate up to 360 guests, but is also suitable for smaller weddings. It is centrally located in the beautiful riverside Georgian town of Pershore and has ample parking nearby.

St James the Great, Birlingham

The pretty village church of Birlingham is famous for its blanket of early spring snowdrops. The church itself was rebuilt in 1871 but retains a 15th Century tower from an earlier building and the lychgate is formed from the chancel arch of the original 12th Century Norman church. With a capacity of approximately 180 it can easily accommodate larger weddings whilst maintaining a rural atmosphere.

St Nicholas, Pinvin

A tiny Church set amidst the fields with parts dating from the 11th Century. Originally a chapelry of Pershore Abbey this small ancient village church features a series of stunning wall paintings from the 14th, 15th and 17th Centuries. The church has a maximum capacity of 70 guests and is therefore only suitable for small weddings.

St Mary's, Wick

A medieval chapelry of St Andrew's, Pershore, the core of St Mary's is late Norman, with a series of 19th Century restorations. The church features a fine collection of stained glass. With a capacity of 100, St Mary's is ideal for smaller marriage ceremonies and offers the perfect backdrop for a country wedding.

Wedding Reception at The St Andrew's Centre, Pershore

A unique reception venue space capable of seating up to 100 guests., the St Andrew's Centre provides a fully equipped kitchen, toilet facilities and full disabled access—all just a stone's throw away from the Abbey Church.
