ART IN THE ABBEY AND BEYOND

OLIVER JONES AT PERSHORE ABBEY 19 FEBRUARY TO 30 MARCH 2022: After a successful showing at National Trust's Berrington Hall as part of Meadow Arts' exhibition 'Skin Deep,' two works by Oliver Jones will be shown at Pershore Abbey during February and March 2022

Oliver Jones works in pastel chalk, a medium commonly associated with intimate portraiture and gentle landscapes, rather than large format works. His works defy expectations: they are large, but also highly charged.

The two works, #motherandchild and Divine have been selected as they present similarities with certain forms of religious art. The pieces address how different forms of communication can contain social messages about who we are and how we relate to each other. In these cases, looking at body image, the impact of social media and self-image/self-worth.

LOOKING AHEAD TO LENT 2022

We will be preparing our normal flyer detailing the Churches Together in Pershore (CTiP) Lent activities along with those of the Pershore Benefice over the next month, but here's a taster of what is planned. Please be aware that **ALL IN-PERSON** events are currently provisional and are subject to change due to Covid-19.

<u>SHROVE TUESDAY PANCAKES AND CHARITY APPEAL LAUNCH:</u> Our CTiP Charity this year will be **Pershore United Charities** as we look to support our local community moving out of Covid. We hope to be able to hold a pancake event, but will review over the coming weeks due to the Covid situation and will update you through the weekly bulletin.



ASH WEDNESDAY SERVICE WITH IMPOSITION OF ASHES - WEDNESDAY 2 MARCH 1930 AT PERSHORE ABBEY: Joining a service on Ash Wednesday marks the start of Lent. Traditionally a cross made out of ash is marked on a forehead, as a sign of our penitence and God's forgiveness.

<u>COMPLINE BY ZOOM DURING LENT:</u> This quiet and reflective service which will last half an hour will be held every Monday during Lent, commencing on **7 March**, at **1900** via **Zoom**. Please contact me for more information and for the Zoom invitation for each week. *Claire*

LENTEN LUNCHES: We very much hope to be able to run Lenten Lunches with CTiP this year on the following Thursday's in St Andrew's: **10 March, 17 March, 24 March & 31 March.** Once again this event will be subject to Covid and we will update you through the weekly bulletin as plans progress!

<u>LENT COURSE</u>: This year's Lent course organised by CTiP will be based on the film 'Chocolat', the 2000 comedy-drama film, based on the 1999 novel of the same name by the English author, Joanne Harris and starring Johnny Depp and Juliette Binoche.

The hope is to run one session to watch the film and then 5 further sessions to discuss clips and ask questions, with hot chocolate for refreshment, of course!

PALM CROSSES NEEDED FOR ASH WEDNESDAY

This is part of the Worcester Diocese "Pray One For Me" initiative that seeks to reach out to people and offer them the opportunity for their prayers to be heard.

VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES

LIVE STREAMING FROM THE ABBEY: We are now live streaming our main 10.30 Sunday service every week, together with any special services. This is available on our YouTube Chanel (Pershore Abbey Community YouTube) both as it happens and then as a recording afterwards. Feedback has been very encouraging, and the services are regularly viewed both in live and recorded form.

To enable us to provide this service we need a group of trained and enthusiastic volunteers. We are very lucky to have 3 people trained to do this, but we really need two more people to make a regular rota possible. Full training will be provided and you will not be left to do anything on your own until you are fully confident.


