


# Morning Praise for Mothering Sunday

In all our services we take time to think about things that have gone wrong, even on a happy day like this. Others may have had an unhappy childhood and have painful memories. So as part of saying sorry we are going to think of these situations. After the words have been said, we will listen to some music, during which please come up, pick up a stone and place it in front of the altar where we will build a kind of cairn, which is a special pile of stones to help remember things.
