IMPORTANT - COMMUNION UPDATE

We are now able to offer Communion in two kinds at all our Eucharist services across the Benefice. It is still perfectly proper to take communion in one kind only but we do also offer the chalice. However, intinction (the dipping of the bread into the wine) will not be permitted. Also, it would help those administering the chalice if you could hold the base of the chalice when taking the wine. Thank you.

REMEMBERING HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH II: Following the sad and sudden news that our beloved Queen died peacefully at Balmoral on 8 September 2022, we are now making preparations to remember and celebrate the life of Her Late Majesty The Queen.

As further details emerge of the plans for the period of mourning and State Funeral, we will update you on our own services through our social media pages on Facebook, Twitter and Instagram, through our website and by email. It may be that some of our planned services or events across the Benefice may no longer take place or that special services are added, so do make sure you keep yourselves updated.

We take this opportunity to let you know that our churches across the Benefice are open for prayer, reflection and contemplation, to simply light a candle or to leave a message in a Book of Condolence.

Flower tributes may be left at the Preaching Cross in the Pershore Abbey grounds, located just beyond the West Door.

The Pershore Abbey Union Flag was raised on Saturday 10 September for the Accession of King Charles III but will once again be flown at half mast from 1300 on Sunday 11 September as we continue to observe the national period of mourning for Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.

HIS MAJESTY KING CHARLES III: As we mourn the death of one monarch, we also welcome and embrace the Accession of King Charles III, who has pledged his life not only to the service of his people, but to the Church of England.

We share this prayer for the new King:

Everlasting God, we pray for our new King, bless his reign and the life of our nation. Help us to work together so that the truth and justice, harmony and fairness flourish among us; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Everyone is welcome to join the National Pilgrimage to the Shrine of St Edward the Confessor. On Saturday 15 October, 0930—1600, Free Admission.

Visit the Abbey and experience its beauty in an atmosphere characterised by prayer.

A welcome liturgy will be offered on arrival, and pilgrims will be able to pray at the Shrine of St Edward – the king and saint who re-founded the Abbey – and in other spaces set aside in the Abbey.
