CHORAL EVENSONG 1700 05 MARCH PERSHORE ABBEY WITH PEAL BOARD

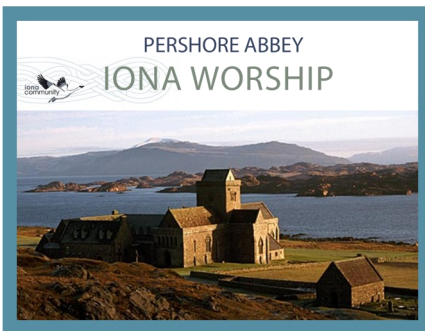
DEDICATION: Please join us on Sunday 05 March for this Choral Evensong service with Pershore Abbey Choir which will include special dedication of our Peal Board.

Peal Boards are often used to record bell ringing that has taken place to mark significant local, national, or international events. These boards are normally mounted on the wall in the ringing room where the bells are rung, though they are occasionally placed on public view within churches. To date, Pershore has had no such peal boards.

We knew that the first peal to be rung on the bells of Pershore Abbey took place on 25 April 1814. On 5 May 2014, a peal was rung at Pershore Abbey to mark the bicentenary of this first peal. We rang 5040 changes of Grandsire Triples and completed our peal in 3 hours 2 minutes. To mark this bicentenary, a peal board has been made to record our performance and the fact that it was rung to mark this 200th Anniversary. The peal board is now being dedicated before it is mounted for display at the end of the walkway leading onto the ringing platform.

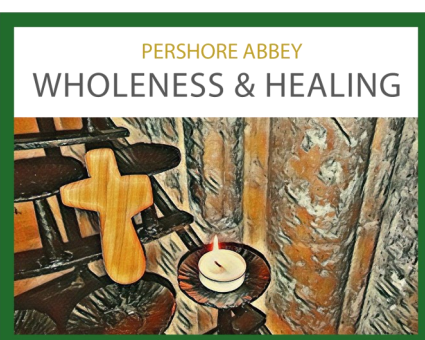

PIPE DREAMS - PERSHORE ABBEY ORGAN INSTLLATION SCHEDULE

We are now entering the final stages of the physical installation and moving towards the voicing stage of the Organ works. A revised schedule of works is now available, so please be aware of the new proposed timings (all subject to change):

- Up to and including **8 March**: Abbey **PARTIALLY OPEN**. Please use the Wick Door and keep to marked areas when inside.
- **9 - 10 March & 15 - 17 March**: Abbey **CLOSED**. The scaffolding will be removed and there will be **NO ACCESS** to the Abbey.
- **17 March - 23 March**: Abbey **PARTIALLY OPEN**. Clearing and a sparkle clean will take place
- **24 March - 26 March**: Abbey **OPEN**.
- **27 March onwards**: Abbey **OPEN**. The Voicing period begins and although the Abbey will be open, **ABSOLUTE SILENCE** is necessary, so please be aware of this at all times during this period.

Our **Daily Offices** and **Sunday Services** will continue to be observed throughout the period but do please keep an eye on the weekly bulletin for updates.

Our Italian installation team have been working hard and doing a marvellous job and the Pipe Dreams team hope you will all agree that this period of disruption will be well-worth it, if early pictures of the finished console are any indication!
