




MIDNIGHT MASS CHRISTMAS EVE 2315: Join us as we gather to celebrate the birth of Jesus and to see in Christmas Day.

PERSHORE BENEFICE VISIT TO SALZWEDEL 6-9 JUNE 2024: Our twin parish of Salzwedel in Saxony-Anhalt, Germany is the capital of the district of Altmarkkreis Salzwedel, and has a population of approximately 21,500. Salzwedel is famous for its half-timbered houses and Baumkuchen (tree cakes). Like Pershore Abbey, the Katherinenkirche is the beating heart of the community. For several years visitors from the Pershore benefice have travelled to Salzwedel to share fellowship with and encourage our fellow Christians. Our German friends have, in turn, visited us. We would love this tradition to continue, and now it is our turn to pay a short visit to Germany. The Salzwedel church community are desperate for us to come and visit soon.






NEWS FROM ST JAMES', BIRLINGHAM

BIG PLASTIC COUNT AND RECYCLING

Last year I took part in the Big Plastic Count, when I recorded all the different types of plastic I used in a week. Every time I opened a packet wrapped in plastic or used up an item of hard plastic I recorded it on the counting pack. When I submitted this at the end of the week I was sent a breakdown result of all the plastics I would use in a year and it was shocking.



Knowing how much we are using provides a good incentive to try and cut down and contribute to the efforts to save the planet from the consequences of plastic waste. As we approach Christmas we are all likely to use even more plastic than usual, so now would be a good time to have a look at the website where they will send your own free, digital counting pack.

I also took part in the Abbey Litter Pick recently and confessed that I have now become slightly obsessed with recycling soft plastics. Virtually everything we buy in the supermarket is packaged in soft plastic but it mostly bears a symbol (green or black) saying 'Recycle', 'Don't recycle' or 'Recycle at a supermarket, not at home' and every week I'm surprised at the size of the bag I take to recycle when I next visit the supermarket. This all might sound like a tedious chore, but the incentive is that every piece we recycle is a contribution to reducing the world's mountain of plastic waste and then it becomes much more satisfying. I hope when you've read this you will decide to join me. *Angela Gerrard*

CHURCHES TOGETHER IN PERSHORE FOODBANK

The volunteers of the Pershore Foodbank have been working hard throughout 2023 to provide emergency food parcels to local people in need; especially families with young children. We operate on a referral system, with clients sent to us by Schools, Churches, Housing Authorities, Social Services and other partners in the Community. We also make onward referrals so that people in crisis can access longer-term assistance and are still able to provide on-site access to Citizen's Advice during our Friday Sessions. *However, it is important to emphasise that no-one is turned away in an emergency.*

We are an **ALL-VOLUNTEER** Foodbank working under the guidance of Trussell Trust with the oversight of our parent charity, Pershore Abbey. Everything practicable is done to keep overheads to an absolute minimum so that the wonderful generosity of our community, whether it is in financial donations or foodstuffs, can be rapidly directed to those most in need.

This year's Harvest Festival produced an amazing quantity of donations. We had over 1 ton of stock donated in September/October, helping to set us up for the busy Winter period. Thankfully, we have been able to recruit several new and enthusiastic volunteers, as all that stock has to be sorted, processed and made up into appropriately selected parcels and many of us are not as young as we would like to think we are.

As well as our routine service, we will be delivering festive hampers in the lead up to Christmas. We are open as normal over the holidays with the exception of Tuesday 26 December. Our phone and email messages will also be monitored. **Donations can also be made at the collection bins in local supermarkets, schools and churches.**


