

CONFIRMATION SERVICE 2026: Confirmation in the Church of England is a really special moment in the life of a follower of Jesus. At a Confirmation Service those who want to be confirmed have taken the decision that the promises that might have been made for them at their baptism when they were a baby or young child, or the faith that they feel they now have as young person or adult, now need to be affirmed publicly for themselves. It is a moment of commitment to follow Jesus, knowing that we are surrounded by the love and prayers of the local Christian community. We get ready for this moment by offering some preparation sessions so those being confirmed can explore more deeply what faith and following Jesus means to them.

We shall be holding a Benefice Confirmation Service at 1030 on Sunday 15 February 2026 at the Abbey. We are delighted that Bishop Michael will be leading this service. If you would like to explore being confirmed as part of your journey of faith please let me know by 30 November. *Claire*





FLYING THE FLAG


Have you ever wondered why the Abbey flags are flying on certain days? For the curious minded, during November, here are the flags that will be flying and why:

Full marks for all our Harvest Festival donors! This year we had such a large quantity of well-chosen items that we have been able to stock up our coffers for weeks to come. There were over 1,000 kilograms of stock for us from local churches and schools and less than 3% was out of date (don't worry, we found a safe use for that too). Another thing that really helped out warehouse volunteers was the way in which so many donor organisations contacted us in plenty of time to arrange collection.

Demand for our services doesn't slow down and, with your support, we continue to provide emergency help to some of the most vulnerable people in our community. So, I'm afraid we are going straight into another set of requests. The Christmas season may seem a long way off but we like to begin preparing our hampers in November. The shops are full of Christmas treats already so chocolates, sweets, biscuits and savouries will be very welcome. Please hold off on the mince pies for the time being as they have such a short shelf life and please, no crackers. Thank you again for being such a wonderful and supportive community.
